## HOW TO PLAY

Set up the space according to the guidelines below. Invite your students to wear their favourite team's jersey or socks.

Students can be sponsored by friends and family for each attempt at penalty goal, with sockball attempts worth more!

The goalkeeper is integral to the game and can join in the fun to save goals. Rotate students, give your teachers the job, or invite special guests to be your goalkeepers!

Ensure each student takes five penalty shots at goal, including one with the handmade sockball.

Position the students from goal dependent upon their age group.

## Suggested:

Infants (five metres), Primary (seven metres) and Secondary (ten metres).

## WHAT YOU NEED

Access to a large space like an oval or courts.
$\rightarrow$ Equipment:

- 4x soccer nets or goal markers (cones, sports sticks etc.)
- $4 x$ soccer balls per goal.
- 1x sockballs per goal (made by students prior to the day - see How to Make a Sockball video.
